Being a Vocational Rehabilitation student through the Department of Veterans Affairs she decided to focus on various internships that would broaden her true passion; helping veterans.

After completing her Masters degree she accepted employment at San Antonio College as an adjunct professor and Vocational, Career, and Educational Counselor as well as a Veterans Certifying Official. Later, she founded Veterans Advocacy Support and Training (VAST) which further served to fuel her desire to serve the veteran community and foster development with other organizations.

Now she is working with Life Management Group to build a strong, lasting veterans service program with the objective to help vets and their families with goal setting, training, transitional assistance, and consistent follow up to reduce the challenges and disappointments they may face.
